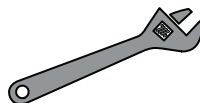
Inspect plumbing for signs of damage. Replace as necessary.

Adjustable Wrench

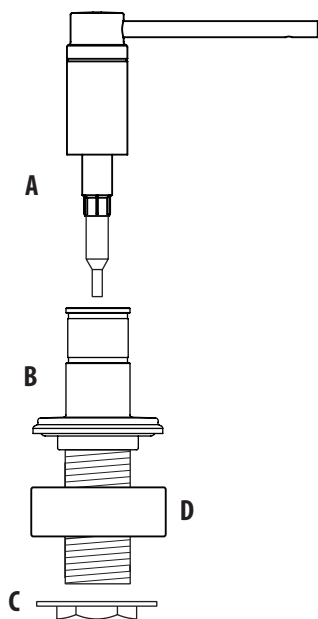

- Component location, spacing, and situational requirements can vary.

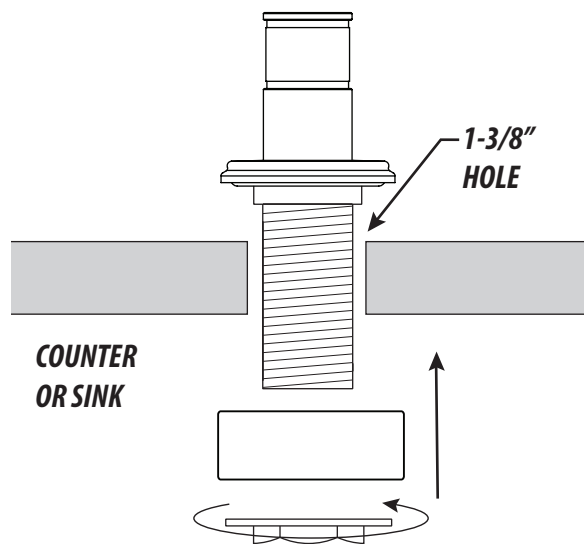
INSTALL SOAP DISPENSER

1.



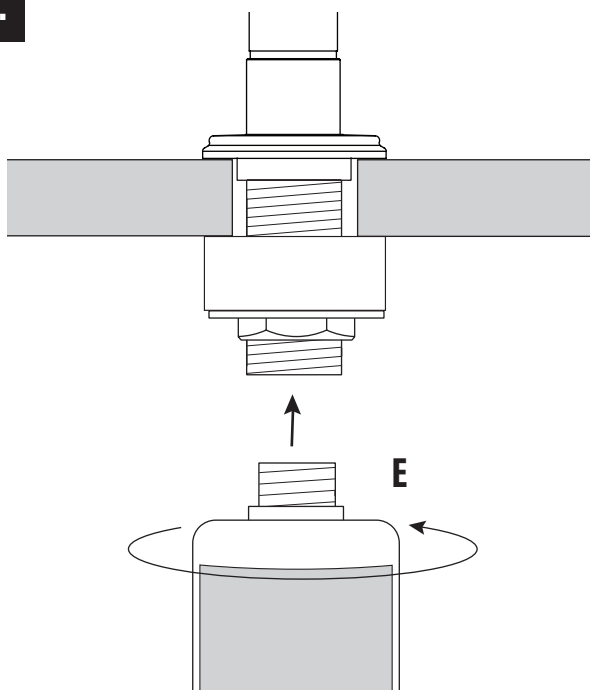
Pull and remove spout (A) from dispenser body (B). Remove clamp nut (C) and brass spacer (D) from threaded shroud.

2.



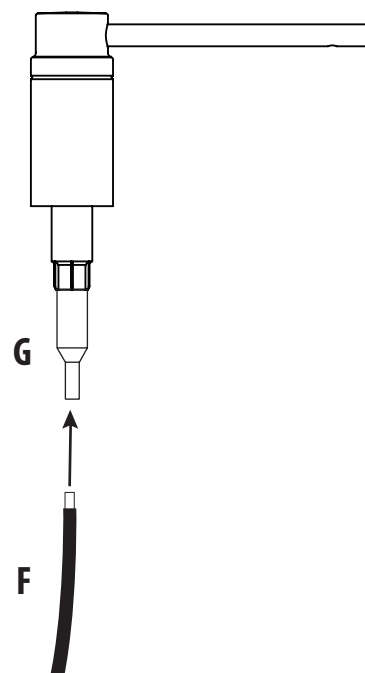
Fit dispenser body through 1-3/8" hole on counter or sink. (No plumbers putty is required). Slide brass spacer onto shroud. Screw clamp nut and tighten snug.

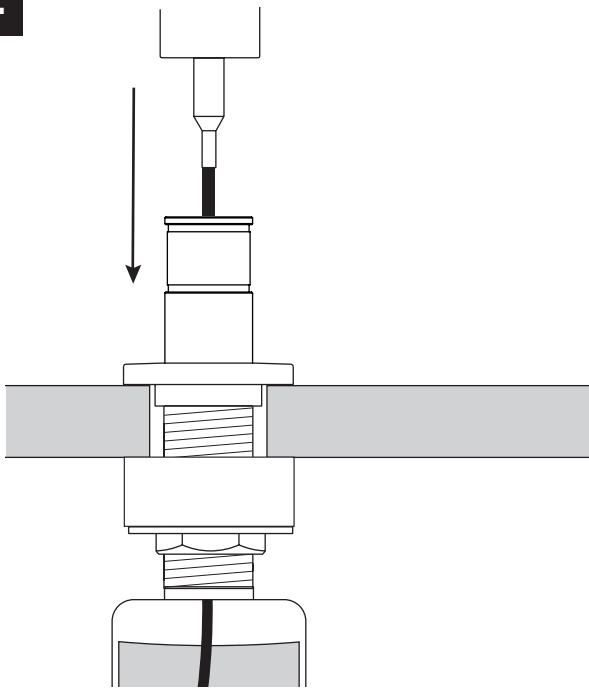
Fill plastic bottle with soap or lotion. Thread bottle (E) into bottom of dispenser shroud.

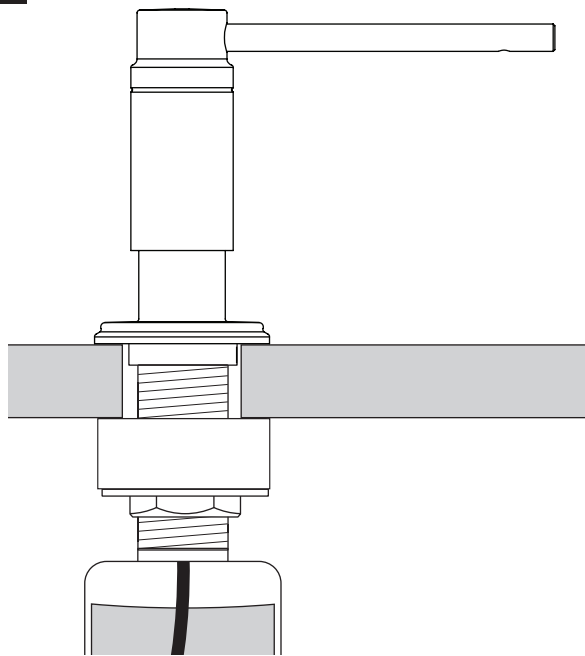
Slide red tubing (F) into tube fitting (G) at bottom of spout.

5.



Insert open end of red tubing down through dispenser base and into plastic bottle.

Push down on spout to secure over white O-rings.
Pump spout a few times to get soap or lotion flowing.
